



## **MAHER- Maa Ka Ghar (Maika)**

**[A project for the Tribals at Jharkand]**



This novel initiative proposes to accommodate battered women and children keeping in mind the negligible social situation that causes them to be orphaned, destitute, suppressed and abandoned.

The objective of this centre would primarily work towards providing the children and women who are in immediate need for shelter with sufficient food and thereafter promoting the holistic development of their abilities, to which they are entitled. We also aim to enable them to become self dependant so that they would finally be equipped to move on from their crisis situation and carry on with their lives.

At present the Maher- Maa Ka Ghar (Maika) project has already begun at Ranchi at a rented home which is housing 29 children (17 boys & 12 girls) and 2 women. The resources at the home however are limited, there by constraining our desire to accommodate more people.

The land for this project is still to be acquired. However we hope to accommodate a total of approximately 100 people which is inclusive of both women and children.
